Dr. Russell De Souza: There is an urgent need to develop scientific temper and scientific literacy in students irrespective of the domain of knowledge they belong to. Considering the needs of the second decade of the 21st century not forgetting the galloping 4th Industrial Revolution which is technology driven, students need avenues to exploit their creative and critical faculties, engage in problem solving, liaise and network through effective communication channels with significant others across global spaces. Thus, the need to urgently set-up a Science Club that would overwhelmingly introduce even a novice to scientific explanations and investigations.

Mrs. Ximena Fonseca opined that mathematical reasoning can be fostered by drawing a connection between theory and its ecological applicability. Mathematics is to train the mental faculties to articulate logic, discover relationships and seek applicability. In other words, the laboratory provides an opportunity for Mathematics the discover mathematics through doing. The various activities would help students to visualize, manipulate and reason.

Dr. Delia Antao suggested that workshops on Copyrights and Trademarks need to be conducted to make both faculty and students aware of their importance in a changing world. She said that very often both the terms are confused. Hence, the need to organise workshops. Ms. Eutemia Fernandes suggested that Prof. Saba Da Silva, Principal of Kare Law College could be invited to conduct the sessions.
